7. Fill out new form for each monthly trading of Ink Cartridges for Reams Of Paper

We trade each month up to four Ink Cartridges of all types and if more Ink Cartridges are in the plastic bag they are bonus to The Recycling Club and The Recycling Club is unable to provide future trading credits etc

The Recycling Club is unable to accept request for trading when students are not in school. This includes Holidays, Breaks and Summer Vacations
